And what does the Lord require of you, But to do justly, To love mercy, And to walk humbly with your God? Micah 6:8b NKJV

1. THOU SHALL NOT BE ______

A double minded man is unstable in all his ways. James 1:8 KJV

"No one can <u>serve two masters</u>. Either you will hate the one and love the other, or you will be devoted to the one and despise the other. You cannot serve both God and money." Luke 16:13 NIV

"Do not <u>follow the crowd</u> in doing wrong." Exodus 23:2

2. THOU SHALL NOT BE

The woman was surprised, for <u>Jews refuse to have anything to do with Samaritans</u>. She said to Jesus, "You are a Jew, and I am a Samaritan woman. Why are you asking me for a drink?" John 4:9 NLT

When Peter came to Antioch, he did something that was <u>not right</u>. I stood against him, because he was wrong. ¹² This is what happened: When Peter first came to Antioch, he ate and associated with the non-Jewish people.
